**Recommendations:**

- i) Members endorse the nomination of SEEC's Chairman to sit as the South East representative on the LGA Executive Committee for 2012-13
 - ii) Members put forward nominations for a South East representative to sit on the LGA Transport Futures Group

1. South East representation

- 1.1 There are two current opportunities for SEEC to nominate South East representatives to sit on LGA groupings. These are:
 - The LGA Executive Committee, which meets monthly in central London
 - The LGA Transport Futures Group, which meets quarterly in locations around the country.
- 1.2 Nominations for these two representatives were deferred at the SEEC AGM in June.
- 1.3 The South East seat on the LGA Executive has traditionally been taken by the SEEC Chairman, so members are asked to endorse Cllr Gordon Keymer as the SEEC representative for the coming year.
- 1.4 In 2011 SEEC was invited to send a representative to the Transport Futures Group, a role that was previously taken by Cllr David Robertson. Following his decision to stand down as SEEC's Transport Convenor, there is now a vacancy for a South East representative on this group.
- 1.5 Members are asked to nominate a SEEC member to join the Transport Futures Group.
