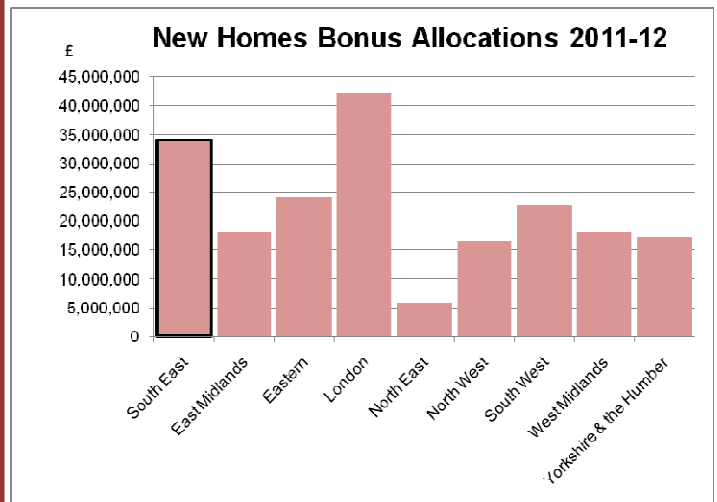
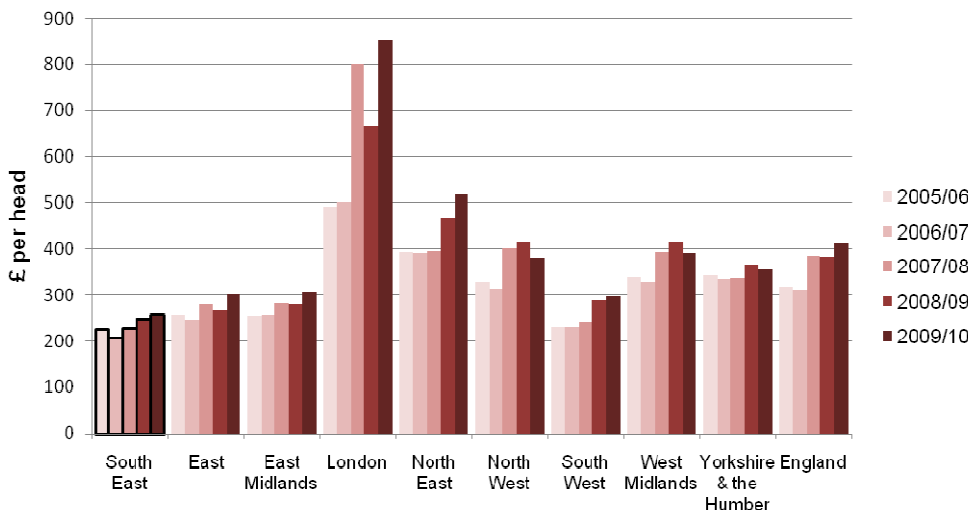


Key Issues/Messages:

- Annual housing completions dropped steeply in the South East between 2008-10 (nearly 9,000 less built in 2010 than 2008), reflecting wider economic conditions.
- Overall the South East the second highest New Homes Bonus allocation (£34m), reflecting the relatively high levels of development compared to elsewhere in England, although individual LA allocations vary considerably.
- At £257 per head, the South East has the lowest levels of capital funding per resident, £155 below the national average, despite significant pressure on services and infrastructure.
- Overall there remains need for significant funding to address infrastructure needs in the South East.

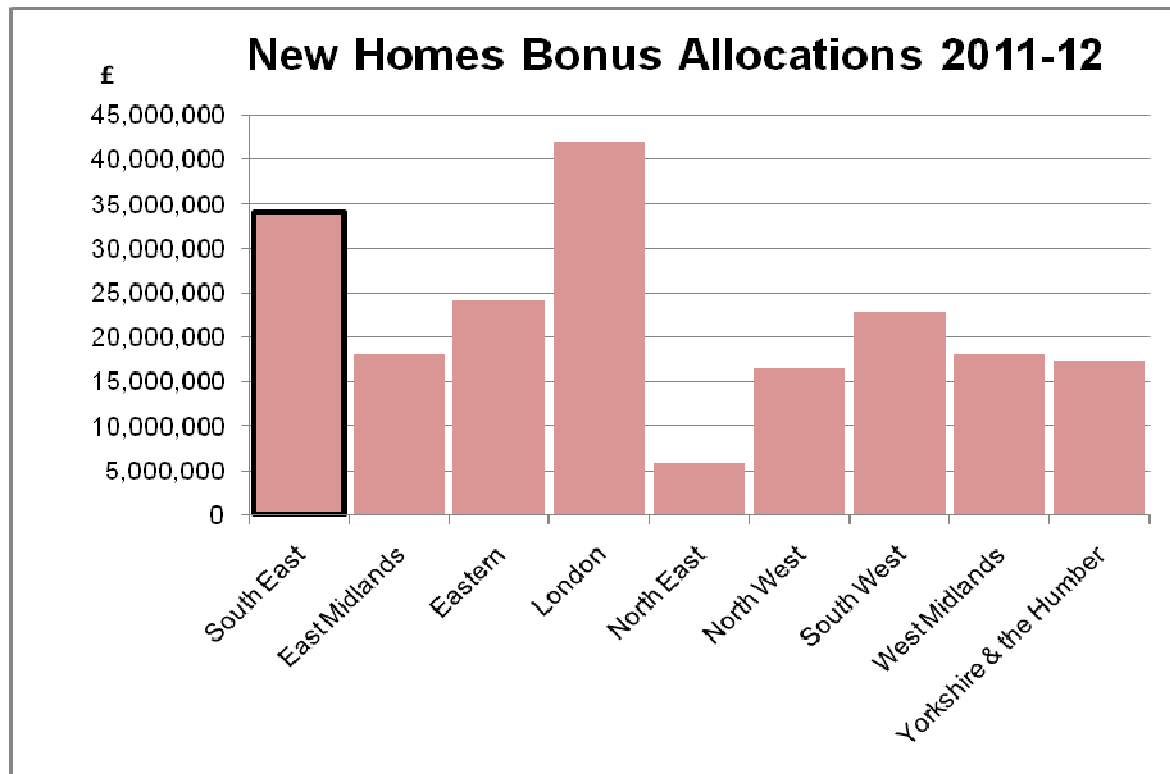
