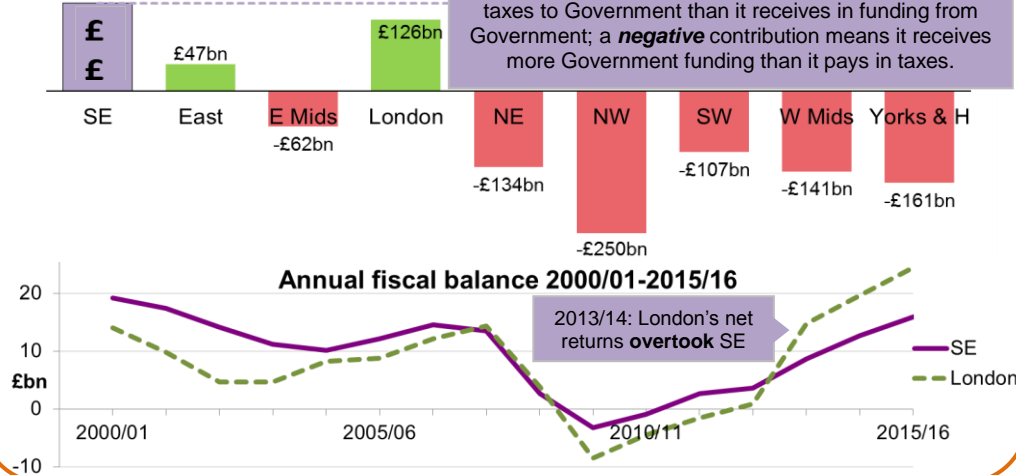

At **£154bn** between 2000/01 & 2015/16, SE made highest net tax contribution to Treasury, £28bn more than London. But London's returns have **overtaken SE** since 2013/14.

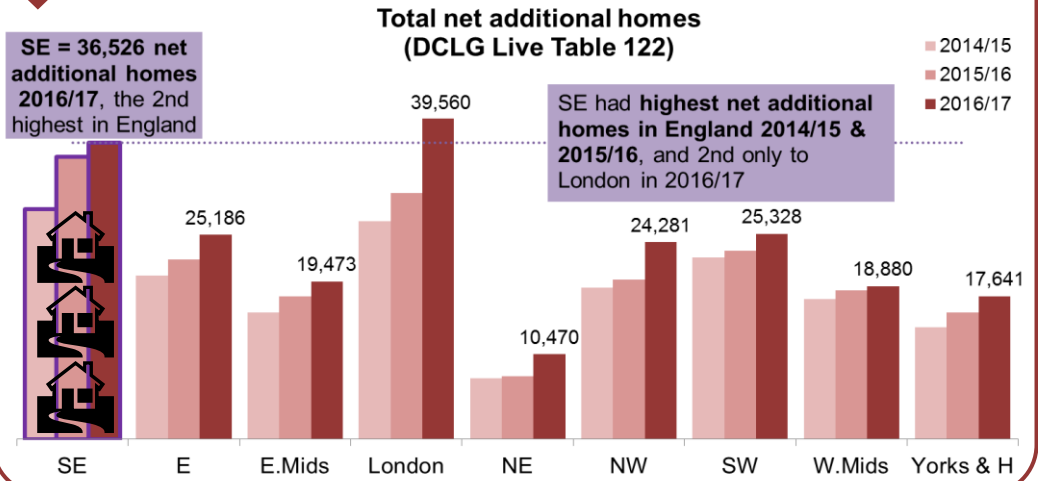
SE = £154bn net contribution to Treasury, highest in England

**Total residence-based contributions to UK public finances, 2000/01-2015/16 (Source: Oxford Economics for SEEC)**

A **positive** contribution means the area pays more taxes to Government than it receives in funding from Government; a **negative** contribution means it receives more Government funding than it pays in taxes.

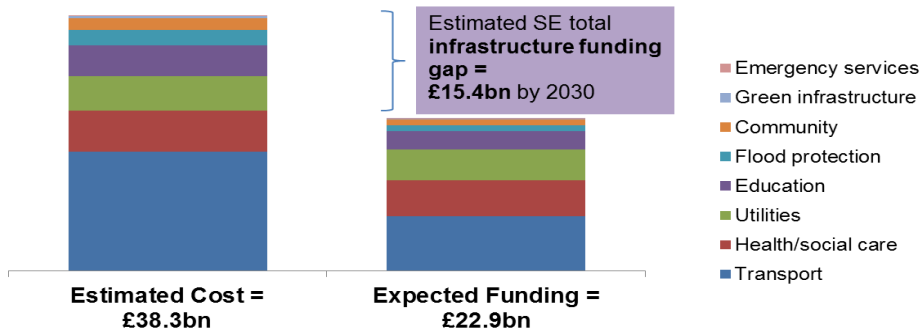


SE had the 2<sup>nd</sup> highest net addition of homes in 2016/17 at **36,526**, a significant 1,684 increase on the previous year.



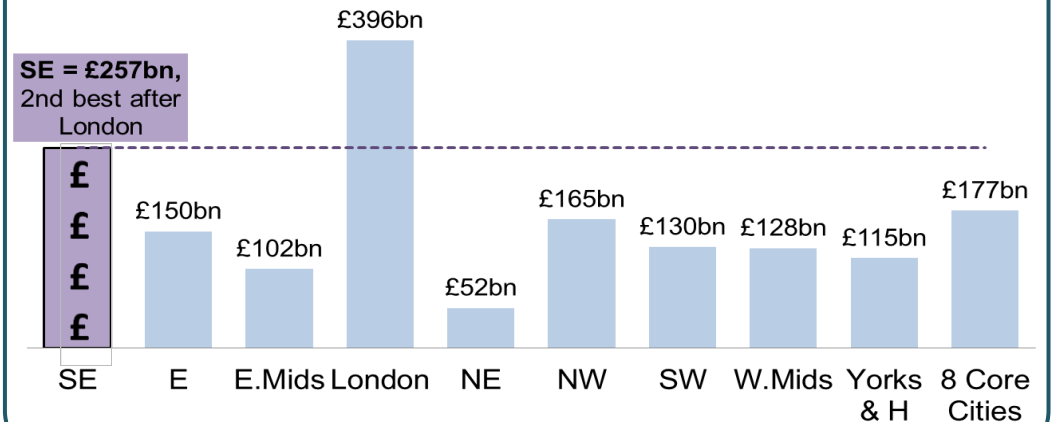
**£15.4bn** SE infrastructure investment gap by 2030, restricting economic growth and harming public services if not addressed.

At **£257bn** in 2016, SE economic output (GVA) is 2<sup>nd</sup> highest in England, and more than all 8 core cities combined.

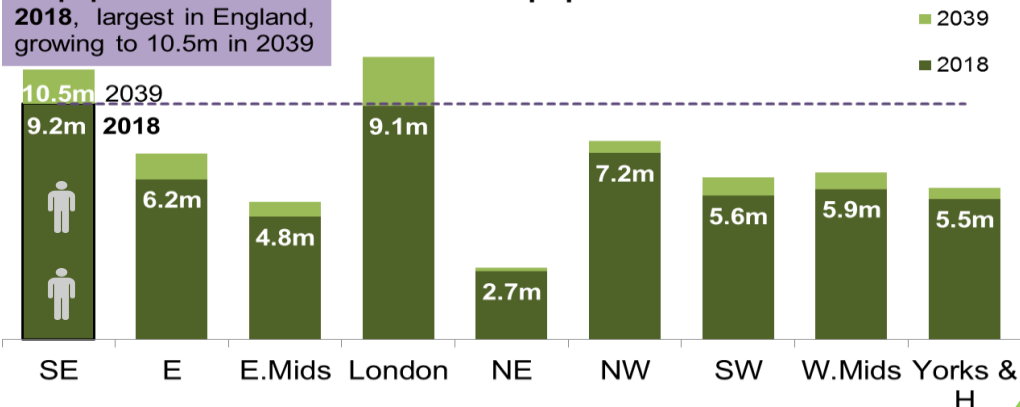

At **9.2m** in 2018, SE has UK's largest population, projected to **grow to 10.5m by 2039**.

**Sub-national population projections (2014-based) - total population 2018 and 2039**

SE population = 9.2m in 2018, largest in England, growing to 10.5m in 2039



SE has **77,540** people claiming unemployment benefits - higher than E, E Mids, NE & SW; & 18% more than April 2017.

**Total number of people claiming unemployment benefits - April 2018**

SE claimants increased by 18% during the last year, **higher** than the national 14% increase

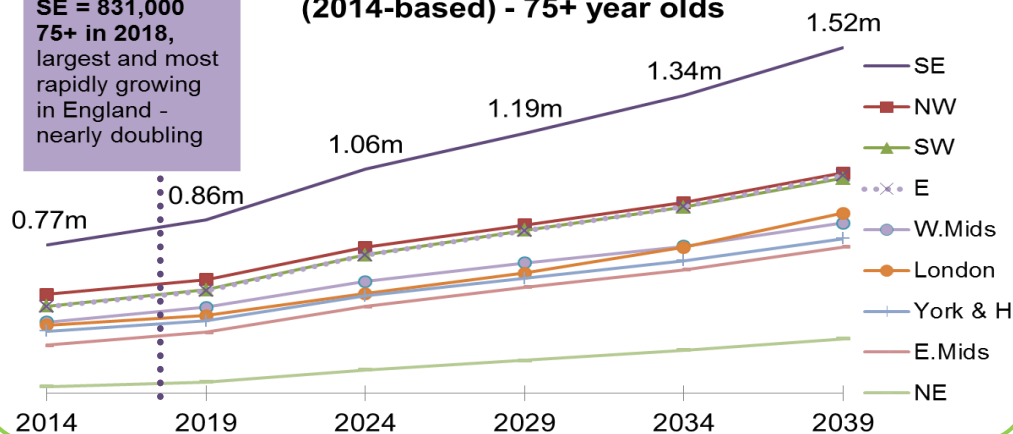
SE = 77,540 unemployed. E, E.Mids, NE and SW have less



At **831,000** in 2018, the SE has UK's largest older population, with over-75s nearly doubling to **1.5m** by 2039.

**Sub-national Population Projections (2014-based) - 75+ year olds**

SE = 831,000 75+ in 2018, largest and most rapidly growing in England - nearly doubling



SE has **909,000** people living in income deprivation, the 4<sup>th</sup> highest in England.

**Index of Multiple Deprivation 2015 - People living in Income Deprivation**

SE = 909,000 people income deprived, including 233,000 children and 238,000 older people (60+)
