1. Background to action note

- 1.1 SEEC's All-Member Meeting on 1 February 2018 was converted into an expert panel workshop on housing and infrastructure delivery in the South East.
- 1.2 To reflect the high level of member interest in these topics on the first anniversary of the Government's Housing White Paper, other items of SEEC business were covered by a [written activity report only](#). This allowed more time for expert speakers, questions and member discussion on housing and infrastructure.
- 1.3 As a result, minutes were replaced by a [written report of the meeting](#), circulated to members along with speaker slides after the event.
- 1.4 In lieu of minutes, this action note has been produced to record follow on actions arising from the workshop and the written activity report.

2. Action points following SEEC All-Member meeting on 1 February 2018

ACTION 1: SEEC to submit formal response to the Mayor of London's consultation draft of his New London Plan by the closing date of 28 February 2018.

ACTION 2: Follow up SEEC letter to new Housing Minister Dominic Raab to arrange a meeting and provide further briefing on South East housing opportunities and challenges.

ACTION 3: Finalise and publish a good practice guide for councillors working with LEPs on Local Industrial Strategies.

ACTION 4: Finalise and send letter to Immigration Minister Caroline Nokes highlighting concerns around shortages of funding for South East local authorities who accept Unaccompanied Asylum Seeking Children.

ACTION 5: Take account of points raised at February's expert panel in responding to the next stage of Government's consultation on implementing proposals from the 2017 Housing White Paper.
