As you will know, SEC is a representative body of 44-member councils, the voice of most local authorities across the South East of England. We are a cross-party association that campaigns to ensure that the South East is a great place to work, live and do business.

We would also like to share our thanks for your valued contribution to the *South East APPG* as a Vice-Chair. We have come some way since the inquiry into levelling up by the APPG, which highlighted challenges and deprivation in the South East and underscored the need for levelling up within the region as much as in parts of the North and Midlands.

SEC will be considering what fiscal levers for financial devolution in the region could be appropriate in our proposed South East Finance Commission (SEFC), which aims to undertake an investigation akin to the London Finance Commission and is expected to report early next year.
