Dear Shadow Minister,

On behalf of South East Councils (SEC), we offer our congratulations on your appointment as Shadow Minister for Local Services and Communities.

As a representative body of 44 member councils, SEC is the voice of most local authorities across the South East of England. We are a cross-party association that campaigns to ensure that the South East is a great place to work, live and do business.

Published twice a year in partnership with Savanta ComRes, our South East 1,000 regional monitor presents the largest and most authoritative regular survey of councillor, business and public opinion in the region. This includes *services*. Our most recent issue found that when asked if they would support or oppose their local area gaining more power on specific policy areas, there was clear and strong support for more local control over the policy areas of Transport (77%), Skills (75%) and Housing (74%).

The last report published by the APPG for the South East, chaired by Sally-Ann Hart MP with SEC serving as secretariat, highlighted the potential of devolving powers to the local level in order to improve the delivery of community services in its inquiry: "Financing the Future – What does levelling up mean for South East England?". Whilst our Summit of the South East (SOTSE), co-hosted by SEC, Localis thinktank and the MJ, brought together place leaders with the Local Government Minister at the time, Paul Scully MP, to discuss shared challenges and opportunities to improve local services.

Moving forward, SEC will be considering what format of fiscal devolution in the region may be of most benefit to communities in our proposed *South East Finance Commission (SEFC)*. It aims to undertake an investigation similar to the London Finance Commission and is expected to report early next year.

We look forward to working with you, and once again, congratulate you on your new role.
